MS Boys Score in Colby By Judy Rogers

The Golden Plains Middle School boys track team scored in several events at the Colby Invitational Track Meet in May 7. The eighth grade team competed separately from the 7th grade boys.

In the 8^{th} grade division, Wyatt Amlong placed second in Discus with a PR distance of 93' 3". He also set a PR in Shot Put of 31' 5". Josh Rath set a PR in the Triple Jump of 30' 10" for 6^{th} place. He also placed 5^{th} in Long Jump at 14' 5".

Maddix Green ran the 3200m for the first time and placed fourth at 13:55.46. Also placing fourth was the 4×800 m relay team of Owen Patmon, Dominic Stout, Abe Taylor, and Maddix Green. This was the first time the middle school had run the 4×800 m so they set the base for the school record at 11:59.27.

The $4 \times 100 \text{m}$ relay team of Patmon, Rath, Taylor, and Amlong ran the best time of any $4 \times 100 \text{m}$ combination this year at 1:02.24 for fifth place. The $4 \times 200 \text{m}$ relay placed sixth at 2:04.63 run by Patmon, Rath, Stout, and Green.
