

MS Bulldogs Compete at Hill City

The Golden Plains Middle School boys competed at the Hill City Invitational track meet on April 26. The 7th and 8th grade were split into two divisions.

The 8th grade placed tenth with all seven of their points coming from Maddix Green. He ran a 6:15.86 in the 1600m run which was good for third place and a new personal record (PR). He placed sixth in the triple jump with a jump of 29'3". Also setting PR's were Owen Patmon in the long jump 12'3", Wyatt Amlong threw the shot put 31'3.25" as well as Able Taylor setting a personal record with a throw of 21'7.5".

Additional results from the 8th grade goes as follows: 100m-Dominic Stout 15.10 and Aidan Pawlak 17.50; 200m-Patmon 31.66, Stout 32.88, and Pawlak 44.02; 400m-Pawlak 1:33.83; 800m-Green 3:05.68; 1600m-Patmon 6:43.12 and Taylor 7:42.48; long jump-Josh Rath 13'2.5"; triple jump-Stout 26'7"; discus-Taylor 66'8" and Amlong 63'2"; 4x100m relay-Amlong, Pawlak, Taylor, Stout 1:04.38; and the 4x200m relay-Patmon, Green, Amlong, Rath 2:10.64.

The 7th grade found more success. They placed fifth scoring 41 points. Leading the scoring for the Bulldogs was Dylan Wark who won the 800m with a personal record time of 2:27.53. He also placed third in the 100m hurdles 17.06, fourth in the 200m hurdles 35.45, and fifth in the long jump 14'1". Diego Perez placed second in both long jump 15'2" and triple jump 31'8". Perez also found success in the distance races. He placed fifth in the 1600m run 6:11.38 and sixth in the 3200m run 15:52.15.

Additional results for the 7th grade: 100m-Tanner Black 19.14; 200m-Black 43.11; 800m-Zeke Weiner 3:17.98 (PR); and 3200m-Weiner 15:52.15.

The MS teams will compete again in the rescheduled Northern Valley Invitational in Logan on April 29.
