MS Boys Win at Logan By Judy Rogers

The Golden Plains Middle School boys track team placed first at the Logan Invitational on May 4 with 7th and 8th grade boys scoring 154 points for the title.

Claiming first place points for the team was Diego Perez who won the 400m dash (1:04.58) and the 1600m run with a PR of 5:38.29. He also placed first in Long Lump at 15' 11" and set a PR of 33' 3" for first in Triple Jump. Dylan Wark placed first in the 800m run (2:41.57) while the 4 x 200m relay team of Owen Patmon, Tanner Black, Josh Rath, and Maddix Green won the race with a time of 2:09.39. The 800 spring Medley team of Patmon, Wyatt Amlong, Dominic Stout, and Wark claimed first with a time of 2:06.32.

Placing second at the meet was Owen Patman with a PR of 29.72 in the 200m dash and Maddix Green with a PR of 6:14.82 in the 1600m run. Wark placed 2nd in the 100m hurdles (17.15) as did Wyatt Amlong in both Shot Put (30' 7") and Discus (84' 4").

Third place points were awarded to Green-800m (2:51.33), Rath-Softball (166' 4") and the 4 x 100m relay team of Josh Rath, Abe Taylor, Tanner Black, and Dominic Stout (1:03.45). Placing fourth was Black-400m (1:19.47), Stout-200m hurdles (35.80), Rath-Long Jump (14' 7.5" PR), Green-Triple Jump (28' 3.5", and Taylor-Discus (71' 5").

Additional points went to fifth place finishers Amlong-100m (15.49 PR), Aidan Pawlak-400m (1:30.30), Wark-Long Jump (14' 6"), Taylor-Shot Put (23' 2"), and sixth place finisher Ezekiel Weiner-1600m (6:47.50 PR) and 800m (3:08.98 PR).

Results of additional events include: 100m—Pawlak 17.58, Taylor 17.58; 200m-Pawlak 43.44; Softball Throw—Weiner (108' 9"), Black (101' 6"). The boys will compete again in Colby on May 7.
