Bulldogs Win League Track By Judy Rogers

The Golden Plains Middle School boys track team won the WKLL League Championship at the track meet held in Logan on May 13. All 7th and 8th grade boys competed together in the 8th grade division to score 136.5 points and claim the first league championship in recent memory. "It was exciting to win league," said Dylan Wark, 7th grade. "We just did our jobs and the results came." "Coach Aumiller wanted to win," added Wark. "He said we could. He figured out what events we all needed to be in."

Several boys claimed individual championships including Dylan Wark who set a PR of 2:25.84 in the 800m run and won the 100m hurdles at 17.51. Dominic Stout won the 200m hurdles in 36.46 seconds.

Diego Perez set new PR's to win the league championship in the 1600m run (5:33.72). He won both the Long Jump 15' 7.5" and Triple Jump 34' 0.25" (PR). He placed second in the 400m dash at 1:04.30. Perez placed in the 1600m in every meet he ran in this season and placed first or second in both long jump and triple jump as well as the 400m all year.

Also placing 2nd at league was the 4 x 200m relay team of Owen Patmon, Josh Rath, Tanner Black, and Stout running 2:07.63. Placing third was Patmon-200m 30.74, Maddix Green-1600m 6:04.72 (PR), Ezekiel Weiner-3200m 15:20.47, Dylan Wark-high jump 4' 6", Josh Rath-long jump 14' 7.5", triple jump 32' 0.75' (PR), the 4 x 100m relay team of Tanner Black, Abe Taylor, Weiner, and Wyatt Amlong (1:08.21), and the Medley relay team of Patmon, Stout, Amlong, and Green (2:18.31).

Fourth place points were awarded to Patmon-400m 1:09.60 and Green 800m 2:54.17. Placing fifth were Amlong-Discus 89' 2" and Wark-Triple Jump 30' 6.5" with sixth place going to Weiner-1600m 7:09.51.

Additional results include: 100m-Aidan Pawlak 20.75, 200m-Black 34.88, Pawlak 44.00, 400m-Black 1:15.32, Shot Put-Amlong 29' 0.25" Taylor 22' 11.75", Discus-Taylor 64' 4", Long Jump-Pawlak 7' 3".

"It was great to win so many personal championships," continued Wark. "I know I did my best. My goal next year is to set a new school record in the 800m."
