

MS Girls Win at Logan

The Golden Plains Middle School girls won the Logan Invitational Track meet on May 4 in Logan. Both 7th and 8th grade girls competed together for 99 points.

Braylee Knowles set a new PR of 17.49 in the 100m dash. McKinzie Horobik placed 6th in the 400m with a time of 1:31.57. In the 800m run, Anette Hernandez placed first (2:57.68) while Anaïs Cepeda set a PR of 3:05.72 for second. Jaqueline Manriquez set a PR of 3:10.56 placing fourth.

Hernandez also placed first in the 1600m run (6:26.69) while Hayden Wark finished 5th (7:06.82) and Myah Ritter placed 6th (7:31.28). Mariah Barnett ran a 19.82 for 2nd in the 100m hurdles with Wark placing 4th at 20.42. Barnett set a PR of 34.20 for first place in the 200m hurdles with Wark placing 5th at 37.50.

The 4 x 100m relay team of Knowles, Manriquez, Emma Carter, and Horobik ran a 1:09.57 for 5th place. The 4 x 200m relay team placed 2nd at 2:15.91 with Siena Vargas, Ritter, Cepeda, and Horobik running. The 800 sprint medley team placed 1st at 2:18 run by Vargas, Barnett, Ritter, and Hernandez.

In field events, Hernandez tried high jump for the first time this season and placed 3rd with a 4' 2" jump. Barnett set a PR of 12' 5" for 2nd place in Long Jump. Vargas jumped 10' 0.5" and Horobik set a PR of 9' 8.5". Wark set a PR of 27' 9.5" for 2nd in Triple Jump while Ritter set a PR of 25' 9.5" for 4th place. Vargas jumped 24' 2.5".

Emma Carter placed 6th in Shot Put with a 24' 8.75" throw. Knowles threw 24' 6.75 to finish 7th. Carter also placed 6th in Discus at 52' 6". In the softball throw, Knowles placed 6th at 110' 3" while Cepeda threw 103' 8" and Carter 66' 3".

The girls will compete again on May 7 in Colby.
