MS Girls Place Second at Northern Valley By Judy Rogers

The Golden Plains Middle School girls track team competed at the rescheduled Northern Valley Invitational track meet in Logan on April 29. The team including 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grades combined, scored a total of 84 points for second place at the meet

Many of the girls set new PR's with others placing well in the top six. The relay teams performed well with the 800m Relay team of Siena Vargas, Myah Ritter, Anais Cepeda, and Hayden Wark placing first with a time of 2:16. The 800 medley Relay team of Vargas, Jaqueline Manriquez, Wark, and Anette Hernandez also placed first with a 2:18 run.

Mariah Barnett placed second in the 100m hurdles (19.57) while Wark finished right behind her in third (19.58). Hernandez placed second in the 400m dash (1:14) while Cepeda set a new PR for second place in the 1600m run (6:59.)

All three girls set new PR's in the 200m hurdles including Wark- $3^{rd}$  (36.00), Barnett- $4^{th}$  (36.18), and Hernandez- $5^{th}$  (36.45). Fourth place also went to Ritter with a new PR in Triple Jump (25 '2.5"), Hernandez in 100m (14.7), Manriquez in 1600m with a new PR (7:19), and Cepeda with a PR of 3:16 in the 800m run.

Manriquez set a PR in the 800m run for 5<sup>th</sup> place (3:19) and the 400m relay team of Mariah Barnett, Emma Carter, Braylee Knowles, and McKinzie Horobik placed fifth running a 1:09. Sixth place points were awarded to Braylee Knowles in Shot Put (24'4") and Emma Carter in Discus (50' 11").

The sixth grade girls also competed well posting 55 points at this meet. Results include: Shot Put—Marisol Perez 21' 4" (4<sup>th</sup>), Katie Carter 20' 5" (6<sup>th</sup>); Discus—Kailee Wessel 50' 4"; 100m Hurdles—Lesly Holguin 29.47 (2<sup>nd</sup>), Perez 31.04 (3<sup>rd</sup>); 100m-Kailee Wessel 16.7 (6<sup>th</sup>); 400m Relay—Holguin, Jordyn Bange, Estella Vargas, Addy Wessel 1:13.1 (3<sup>rd</sup>); 400m—Holguin 1:28.9 (3<sup>rd</sup>), K. Carter 1:30.0 (4<sup>th</sup>), K. Wessel 1:30.0 (5<sup>th</sup>); 800m—Holguin 3:19.3 (1<sup>st</sup>), Bange 3:27.9 (5<sup>th</sup>); 200m—K. Wessel 37.58 (6<sup>th</sup>).
