Sixth Grade Girls Score in Logan By Judy Rogers

The sixth grade girls competed in their own division at the Logan Invitational on May 4 and scored 81 points for 6th place. In the 100m dash, Marisol Perez placed 4th (17.29), Kailee Wessel 5th (17.83), and Estella Vargas set a PR of 18.02 for 6th place.

In the 200m, Perez placed 5th (35.50), K. Wessel 6th (36.80 PR), and Vargas 7th (37.50). K. Wessel finished 2nd in the 400m (1:34.16), Vargas 3rd (1:40.72), and Luisa Ramirez 4th (1:41.04). Jordyn Bange placed 3rd in the 800m run (3:39.06) with Ramirez placing 4th (3:46.43). Katie Carter ran the 100m hurdles in 24.77 seconds for 2nd place.

E. Vargas, Addy Wessel, Perez, and K. Carter placed first in the 4 x 100m relay at 1:10.86. Jordyn Bange placed third in high jump (3' 2") while A. Wessel placed 4^{th} in long jump (7' 1.5"). Ramirez placed 5^{th} in long jump (7' 0" PR) and Bange 6^{th} (6' 2"). In shot put, Perez finished 4^{th} (20' 11.5") and A. Wessel 5^{th} (19' 4.25"). K. Wessel set a PR of 48' 3" 9" in Discus for 3^{rd} while K. Carter threw 45' 10" for 5^{th} .

The girls' final event was the softball throw. This was the first time they had ever competed in this event. A. Wessel threw 69; 10", K. Carter 67' 11", and Bange 56' 2". The girls' next meet will be in Colby on May 7.
