

Bulldogs Set 16 PR's at Logan

The Golden Plains Bulldog Track Team set 16 Personal Records (PR) at the Logan Invitational in Phillipsburg on May 2. They scored 63 points to place third in the meet.

Sophomore Josh Rath set a PR of 37' 0" in Triple Jump for second place. Also placing second was Dylan Wark with a PR of 44.67 in the 300m Hurdles and the 4 x 800m relay team with the best time of any combination of runners so far this season with a time of 9:23.55 run by Owen Patmon, Landon Meier, Wark, and Iu Ribera.

Third place points were awarded to Landon Meier with a PR run of 5:05.44 in the 1600m, Ezekiel Weiner in the 3200m with a run of 11:50.29, Iu Ribera in Triple Jump (35' 4.5"), and to the 4 x 400m relay team of Meier, Rath, Ribera, and Wark with a PR run of 3:54.80.

Placing fourth was Ribera with a 59.05 PR in the 400m, Tanner Black with a PR Triple Jump of 33' 10.5", and Dominic Stout with a 22.34 run in the 110m Hurdles. Weiner placed fifth in the 1600m with a PR time of 5:24.87 and Stout placed sixth in the 300m Hurdles running 57.28.

Additional PR's were set by Tanner Black in the 100m (13.09), Maddix Green 100m (13.85) and 200m (28.52), Josh Rath 200m (27.61), Owen Patmon 800m (2:34.42) and 1600m (5:43.94), Miguel Garcia Discus (77' 3"), Wyatt Amlong Shot Put (33' 9.5"), and the 4 x 100m Relay team of Abraao Alencar, Wyatt Amlong, Miguel Garcia, and Abe Taylor (55.67).

Results of other events include: 100m-Garcia 15.76, 200m-Black 27.60, 400m-Meier 1:01.64 Stout 1:07.40, Long Jump-Rath 16' 1" Black 14' 8" Taylor 12' 5", Discus-Will Bruggeman 91' 4" Amlong 87' 6", Javelin-Amlong 89' 10" Taylor 89' 7" Alencar 72' 0", Shot Put-Bruggeman 33' 1" Alencar 32' 0.5".

It's been a fun season," said Abraao Alencar. "I've enjoyed working with my teammates in the 4 x 100 and we try our best in shot and discus." "The hard work we are putting in is paying off," added Coach Travis Smith. "I'm very proud of what our kids are accomplishing." The Dogs will continue to improve as they compete at the Colby Invitational on May 5.
