

Bulldogs Place Third at WKLL Meet By Judy Rogers

The Golden Plains High School boys track team placed third at the WKLL league meet in Hill City on May 12. The Dogs scored 87 points to place behind Northern Valley with 136 and Weskan with 93.

Several events claimed league championships including Dylan Wark with a PR of 2:08.70 in the 800m and Landon Meier in the 1600m with a run of 5:05.58. The 4 x 800m relay team of Meier, Owen Patmon, Iu Ribera, and Wark ran a PR of 9:12.07 for first place.

Wark placed second in the 110m Hurdles with a PR of 17.92 while Josh Rath set a PR of 37' 7.5" for second in Triple Jump. Ezekiel Weiner set a PR of 11:43.95 in the 3200m run for third place. Ribera placed third in Triple Jump with a PR of 37' 0". Both Rath and Ribera joined Meier and Wark to place third in the 4 x 400m relay with a PR time of 3:53.60.

Earning points in fourth place was Wyatt Amlong with a 33' 11.75" throw in Shot Put, Dominic Stout with a 22.95 run in the 110m Hurdles, and Tanner Black with a PR run of 12.26 in the finals of the 100m dash. Black also placed fifth in the finals of the 200m dash with a PR time of 25.85 and Weiner placed fifth in the 1600m running 5:28.84.

Final points were awarded to Rath with a PR of 18' 0.5" for sixth place in Long Jump. Amlong threw 99' 9.5" for sixth place in Discus and Ribera placed sixth in the 400m with a 1:00.21 run.

Several events had PR times and distances falling just short of points including Black-Long Jump 15' 9.5" and Triple Jump 34' 4.5", Abraao Alencar-Discus 91' 9", Miguel Garcia-Discus 84' 4.5", Abe Taylor-Javelin 102' 2", Amlong-Javelin 99' 0", and Maddix Green-100m 13.49.

Results of additional events included 100m-Garcia 14.79, 200m-Rath 27.35 Green 28.37, 400m-Meier 1:01.64 Patmon 1:03.30 Green 1:06.96, 800m-Weiner 2:42.34 Patmon 2:45.56, 1600m-Patmon 5:46.21, 300m Hurdles-Stout 57.78, Long Jump-Taylor 13' 1.5", Shot Put-Alencar 29' 11.25" Garcia 29' 1.5", Javelin-Alencar 83' 5".

The boys continue to work hard in practice as they prepare to compete in Regionals on May 19 in Tribune.
