

Lady Bulldogs Place Second in Colby By Judy Rogers

The Golden Plains Lady Bulldogs placed fifth overall and second in Class 1A at the Colby Invitational Track Meet on May 5 with 18 teams competing. The girls scored 50 points and set 7 Personal Records.

Breanna Rath placed first in Triple Jump with a 36' 5" jump and second in Long Jump with a PR jump of 16' 4.75". Rath has placed first in Triple Jump at every meet this season and set a new school record earlier in the year. She has placed in the top three in Long Jump all season.

Emma Weiner won both the 1600m and 3200m runs. She ran the 1600 in 5:38.89 and has placed in the top two spots all season. She ran a season best of 11:58.61 in the 3200m—an event she has won at every meet the past two years.

The 4 x 800m relay team of Weiner, Sidney Taylor, Jordyn Fleckenstein, and Anette Hernandez also placed first with a PR time of 10:35.42. They, too, have finished in the top three all season.

Sidney Taylor set a PR of 2:39.29 in the 800m for sixth place and Anette Hernandez placed sixth in the 1600m running in 6:16.41. Rath set a PR of 13.79 in the 100m and Siena Vargas set a PR of 27' 4" in Triple Jump and a PR of 12' 0" in Long Jump.

Additional results include: 100m-Vargas 15.85, Ava Brantley 15.87, 200m Brantley 33.33 Vargas 34.10, 800m-Hernandez 2:48.63, 4 x 400m Relay-Weiner, Taylor, Rath, Hernandez 4:38.10, Discus-Valentina Bermudez-76' 1" Fleckenstein 75' 0", Javelin-Fleckenstein 69' 8", Shot Put-Bermudez 27' 0".

The girls look forward to the WKLL meet in Hill City on May 12 in hopes of claiming multiple league championships.
