MS Boys Compete at Quinter By Anette Hernandez

The Golden Plains Middle School Boys Track Team traveled to Quinter to compete at the Quinter Invitational Track Meet on April 28. The 6th, 7th, and 8th grade all competed together and scored 12th place overall with 17 total points.

All 17 of the points were scored by Roberto Araux. Araux ran the 800m for the first time and got second with a time of 2:32.55. Araux also placed second in the 1600m and 6th in the 100m with the time of 12.91.

Many of the boys set new personal records including: Brandon Karnes in the 100m run with an 18.47 time, Koen Shaben jumped 23'5 in triple jump, Nash Zieglemeier threw 39'4" in Discus, Javier Romero in Discus 76'1.5" and the 100m run 19.49, and Parker Vahling set two new personal records, a 32.45 time in the 200m and a 1:14.91 in the 400m. The 4x200m relay included Owen Amlong, Jose Rios, Javier Romero, and Koen Schaben. They ran a new PR with a time of 2:28.28.
