

MS Girls Claim Top Spot at Logan Inv.

The Golden Plains Middle School girls track team claimed the top spot as they won the Logan Invitational in Stockton on May 2. The 7th/8th grade girls scored 111 points to edge out 2nd place Grinnell Middle School by 3 points.

Several girls earned first place in their events including Elizabeth Weiner with a PR run of 6:12.86 and Brenlynn Rath with a PR run of 32.59 in the 200m hurdles, a 14' 3.5" first place jump in Long Jump, and a 32' 7" jump in Triple Jump.

Claiming second place points was Adilyn Meier with a 2:48.10 run in the 800m and a 6:12.94 1600m run. Mayte Hernandez placed second in the 400m dash running a 1:09.71 and the 800m sprint medley placed second with a time of 2:15.56 run by Katie Carter, Evelyn Ortiz, Hernandez, and Weiner.

Weiner also placed third in the 800m with a PR run of 2:48.81 while Hernandez extended the school record in Javelin established at Hill City to 69' 7" for third place.

Estella Vargas finished fourth in the 100m with a 15.51 run. Meier set a PR of 1:11.18 in the 400m for fourth place, and Kailee Wessel placed fourth in the 200m hurdles with a PR run of 35.47. Lakin Wark placed fourth in high jump at 4' 4" and Kadaeln Unrein set a PR of 31' 2.5" for fourth in Shot Put.

Placing fifth was Rath with a PR run of 1:12.14 in the 400m, the 4 x 100m relay team of Carter, E. Vargas, Addy Wessel, and Ortiz running 1:06.9, and the 4 x 200m relay team of Carter, Wark, A. Wessel, and Ortiz with the fastest time so far this season at 2:15.62. A final point was scored by Wark who placed sixth in the 100m hurdles at 20.32.

Several girls set PR's in their events with many just missing out on points. PR's set include: Shayna Altman-100m 16.18 & 200m 34.61, Kailee Wessel-Discus 58' 0", and Marisol Perez 200m 36.16.

Additional results include: 100m-Unrein 17.52, 200m-A. Wessel 36.82, 100m Hurdles-K. Wessel 20.44 Briella Knowles 24.81, Long Jump-Hernandez 10' 10.25" E. Vargas 9' 4", Shot Put-A. Wessel 21' 11.5" Perez 20' 9.5", Discus-Unrein 53' 11" Knowles 51' 2", Javelin-Perez 46' 0" Altman 22' 5".

The girls competed again on May 5 at the Colby Invitational.
