

Two Lady Bulldogs Named to All-League Team By Judy Rogers

Golden Plains High School had two girls named to the Western Kansas Liberty League All-League Volleyball team for their efforts for the Lady Bulldogs this season. “Both Jordyn and Hayden were leaders on this year’s volleyball team and are very deserving of this honor,” said Coach Ashley Arnberger.

Senior Jordyn Fleckenstein was named first team all-league. She had 343 digs, 273 kills, 60 assists, 48 blocks, and 35 Aces this fall. She was also named first team all-league last year and was named to the NWKL/WKLL All-Tournament Team as a junior. She has been selected to play in the Northwest Kansas All-Star game later this month.

“Being chosen all league first team that past two years is an honor,” said Fleckenstein. “We have a lot of good teams in our league, so I really appreciate the coaches recognizing my hard work and efforts this season.”

Junior Hayden Wark was named second team all-league. She received honorable mention last year.
