

MS Girls Claim Wins Over Bobcats By Siena Vargas

The Golden Plains Lady Bulldogs A-Team girls basketball team extended their record to 9-2 with a 31-20 win over the Western Plains/Healy Bobcats at Ransom on February 5.

The girls came out strong in the first quarter making 12 points while only letting the Bobcats score 3. The Dogs continued playing tough defense only letting the Bobcats score 5 while sinking 7 of their own going into half time with the Lady Bulldogs ahead 19-8.

Coming out into the third quarter the Dogs were not able to put up any points and let the Bobcats score 4. The girls found more energy in the fourth and sank 12 points allowing the Bobcats 8 to finish the game strong with a 31-20 Bulldog win.
