TCCF Scholarships Available for the 2017-2018 School Year

Chuck Dempewolf Nursing Scholarship Endowed Fund:

Sponsored by Patrick and Sally Toth

This fund shall support an annual scholarship for a Certified Nursing Assistant to continue their education to become a Registered Nurse. This will be awarded as a reimbursement to the student after completion of their first year of education while maintaining a 3.0 GPA.

Health Sciences Retention Fund Scholarship:

Students eligible to receive this one year, \$1,500 scholarship must be applying for their second year as a college student majoring in a health science field. Preferred applicants will attend Colby Community College, while those attending Ft. Hays University Nursing Department will be a secondary consideration.

Preference will be given to students with financial need. Applicants are not required to be a top scholar, but must show attributes of becoming a good health care provider in their chosen field.

Leilani Thomas Memorial Scholarship Fund:

Sponsored by the Kansas i-70 Association

Students eligible to receive this \$1000 scholarship include Students who are actively involved in, and must submit supporting documentation of, at least one school sponsored extra-curricular activity for the duration of the scholarship funding period. Applicant must not have a criminal record. The scholarship recipient must continue to serve as a role model to fellow students on- and off-campus and maintain a 2.8 GPA.

Terry Strutt Memorial Scholarship Fund:

Sponsored by the Darwin & Tammi Strutt Family

Students eligible for this \$2,000.00 one year renewable scholarship are high school seniors of either Logan or Thomas County planning to attend Colby Community College for at least one year.

To qualify for this scholarship, students must have attained at least a cumulative 2.8 GPA while in high school and must participate in at least one school sponsored extra-curricular activity while attending Colby Community College. Students who receive this scholarship will be expected to be on their best behavior both on- and off-campus, as well as serve as a role model to fellow students and community members.

Thomas County Scholarship Organization Fund:

To qualify for this scholarship, students must meet eligibility requirements and provide general scholarship information. To qualify for this scholarship, a female applicant must be in their Junior or Senior year in college for 2018-2019 school year. She must be a graduate of a Thomas County high school or educated in Thomas County. The student must maintain a 3.0 GPA for the two-year scholarship period. The scholarship application must include three letters of reference. This student must provide official transcripts from all colleges and universities which they have attended.
